Through his HitTheRoad Cultural Journeys, Ahiskal offers a unique blend of music, history, and education with lectures, master-classes, documentaries, and music-themed city tours, inspiring music-curious individuals worldwide. An orchestral pedagogue, he has been conducting youth and conservatory orchestras for over 30 years.
