Andreas Partilla, Orchestra Conductor

Andreas has studied conducting with Professor Bruno Weil at the University of Music and Performing Arts in Munich since 2008. He was a coach for two productions of Mozart's operas *Così fan tutte* and *Don Giovanni* at Schloss Weikersheim as well as assistant conductor and tutor for productions of Orff's *The Wise Woman, Die Bernauerin* and *Carmina Burana* at the Carl Orff Festival in Andechs in both 2012 and 2013. Andreas took over

from Daniel Stratievsky as conductor of the ESME orchestra in September 2013. Since November 2013 he has been coach and assistant at the Kammeroper München and will be taking a position as solo repetiteur at the Staatstheater am Gärtnerplatz for the 2014/15 season.

Eric Weddle, Singers Conductor

This is Eric's fourth season conducting the ESME Singers and he has thoroughly enjoyed watching them grow in both size and ability. Eric has been involved in music for most of his life – from his high school marching band, university jazz band, university choir, musical theatre and barbershop quartets, to teaching general music and directing school choirs for the last fifteen years. He holds masters degrees in Music Education and Instructional

Joseph Noelliste, Big Band Conductor

Joseph is an accomplished conductor, composer, and performer hailing originally from Jamaica. He studied under Dr. Jean Louis Hagenauer and has a diploma from the Royal School of Music in London. He has also regularly performed with Grammy-award winning vocalist Silvia

McNair. Joseph moved to Munich in 2013 with his wife, Erin, who is completing her doctoral studies. At the end of this season, they are moving to Texas where Joseph will start his PhD in Church Music at Baylor University.

Elmar Eggert, Trumpet Soloist

A native of Munich, Elmar studied trumpet with Leo Kappelmeier and Frank Uttenreuther. He has also attended lessons with Maurice André, Guy Touvron and Wynton Marsalis. Elmar became involved in jazz, playing with the Passau-based *Big Band Bavaria* and the Irish National Radio *RTÉ Big Band*. From 2010 to 2012, he was Principal Trumpet with Vienna-based symphony orchestra concentus 21 and played with the Vienna Russian Wind Orchestra and the *Wiener Konzertverein*. Tonight, he will be playing a Selmer G trumpet once owned by French trumpet virtuoso Maurice André.

José Antonio Casas, Clarinet Soloist

José took his first clarinet lesson at the age of nine at the Conservatorio de Música del Liceo in Barcelona (where Rafael Grimal Olmos introduced him to the clarinet). He studied Telecommunications Engineering at the Technical University of Catalonia and was active in their orchestra for more than ten years. Two years ago, his job as an electronic engineer brought him to Munich. José enjoys playing the clarinet in the ESME orchestra and Stadtkapelle in Germering.
