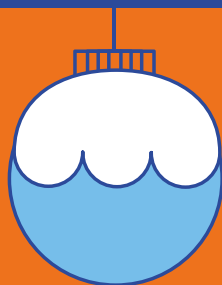

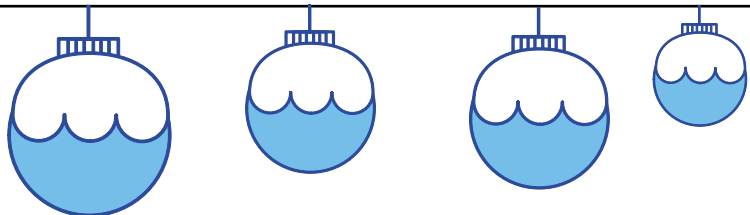

Jochen Stuppi (Esme Singers)

Jochen Stuppi was shaped by his music-oriented high school, his participation as a répétiteur, orchestra-pianist and organist and ultimately his music studies for primary school. He designed many open-air concerts and innovative choir-concepts, often in cooperation with other artists: e.g. "Concert of the Night" and "Paradoxien". Highlight of his career as a conductor was „Snoopy“, a choir adaptation of the Broadway show, written, arranged and directed by him. As a educator for theatre, he loves to offer and design experiences for choirs on stage and their audiences. After 8 years, conducting the „Gemischte Chor Radolfzell“ at Lake Constance, Jochen Stuppi began his work with ESME in September 2022.

Eduardo Browne Salinas (Esme Orchestra)

Eduardo Browne Salinas Studied violin at the Catholic University of Chile and formed himself in orchestral conducting with his father, Maestro Eduardo Browne Puga, as well as with Maestro Rodolfo Fischer. In 2017, he completed an internship in Basel, Switzerland. In 2022 he was awarded third prize in the university-wide competition „Campus Conducting“ in Cologne. As a composer, he has a great interest in the promotion of contemporary music. He is currently studying for his Masters degree in orchestral conducting at HMT Munich, with Professors Marcus Bosch and Georg Fritzsch, alongside his bachelors in composition under the guidance of Isabel Mundry.

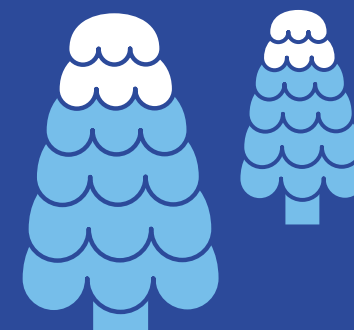
