Alonzo Barrett (Orchestra)

Alonzo Barrett, born in Los Angeles and raised in Southeast Texas, has been pursuing a bachelor's degree in orchestral conducting at the Munich University of Music and Performing Arts since 2021. He began his musical training on the alto saxophone. In 2018 he won second prize in the state of Texas at the TMEA competition. From 2019 to 2021, he studied classical saxophone at the Jacobs School of Music in Indiana with Prof. Dr. Otis Murphy. During this time, he gained his first conducting experience: in 2020, at the age of 18, Alonzo stood on the podium of the Fort Wayne Philharmonic. While a student, he has had the opportunity to work with numerous orchestras, including the Munich Symphony, Munich Chamber Orchestra, Staatstheater am Gärtnerplatz Orchestra, and Staatskapelle Halle, among others. Alonzo is very happy to be able to make music here in Germany, and to get to know German culture and to share music with people.

Julia grew up surrounded by music, dance and theater. She sang in choirs and played flute in orchestra all through her childhood. She received a bachelor's degree in Music at Skidmore College and master's degree in Vocal Performance at Ithaca College before moving to Germany to pursue her postgraduate studies in Vocal Performance at Richard-Strauss-Konservatorium in Munich. Since 2008 Julia has been nurturing two parallel careers – performing as a soloist and teaching early music education. Since joining ESME in 2023 as the Fall Season conductor, Julia has been enjoying the harmony and beauty of so many voices joined together, it's a powerful feeling of community indeed.
