He began his musical training on the alto saxophone. In 2018 he won second prize in the state of Texas at the TMEA competition. From 2019 to 2021, he studied classical saxophone at the Jacobs School of Music in Indiana with Prof. Dr. Otis Murphy. During this time, he gained his first conducting experience: in 2020, at the age of 18, Alonzo stood on the podium of the Fort Wayne Philharmonic. While a student, he has had the opportunity to work with numerous orchestras, including the Munich Symphony, Munich Chamber Orchestra, Gärtnerplatz Staatstheater am Orchestra, and Staatskapelle Halle, among others. Alonzo is very happy to be able to make music here in Germany, and to get to know German culture and to share music with people.

She held a teaching position for piano improvisation at the Musikhochschule München until summer 2020, where she also carried out a project for children with her own musical "Schatten der Zeit". The Resident Alien Big Band


